NOTICE OF RACE

Open Class Championship Contender, Efsix and Flying Dutchman

Bruinisse

VENUE

The Royal Yacht Club Hollandia takes pleasure in inviting you to participate in the Open Class Championship Contender, Efsix and Flying Dutchman class which will be held from 6-8 September 2013 inclusive, and will be sailed off Bruinisse, the Netherlands.

The Organizing Authority is the Royal Yacht Club Hollandia in conjunction with the Royal Netherlands Sailing Association (RNSA).

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the RNSA will apply .
- 1.3 The 'Rules for Championships Sailing and Windsurfing' will apply.
- 1.4 No Racing rules will be changed.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.6 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall be a member of a Yacht club or other body affiliated to the RNSA and shall have the appropriate license

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Contender, Efsix and Flying Dutchman classes.
- 3.2 Entries shall be made on the website: www.kzrvhollandia.nl
- 3.3 Entry closes at 1 September 2013 .

4 FEES

The entry fee is:

Contender class: € 75

Efsix class : € 90

Flying Dutchman class: € 80

and must be paid in cash upon registration, except for the Efsix Class.

Entry fees for the Efsix class must be made by bank transfer to the Dutch Efsix Class Organization. Entries will not be valid until payment is received and confirmed by the Organizing Authority.

7 MEASUREMENTS

- 7.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.
- 7.2 During the regatta, checks on conformity with class rules, including measurement requirements, may be performed at any time.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 8.1 The sailing instructions will be available after 0830 on 6 September 2013 at the Regatta Office.
- 8.2 The sailing instructions will be posted on the website at www.kzrvhollandia.nl when available.

9 VENUE

Attachment 1 shows the location of the regatta harbour and the location of the racing area.

10 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be an Olympic Triangle

11 TIME LIMITS AND TARGET TIMES

- 11.1 The length of the course will be set to meet a target time of approximately 60 minutes for the first boat in each race to finish.
The time limit will be 90 minutes.
Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes rule 62.1(a).
- 11.2 Boats failing to finish within 15 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing. This changes rules 35, A4 and A5.

12 SCORING

12.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 12.2** (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores

13 SUPPORT BOATS

All support boats shall clearly display the 3 letter national code of their ISAF Member National Authority at all times while afloat. The minimum height for the letters shall be 200 mm.

14 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park

15 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

VHF will only be used for safety communication.

16 PRIZES

The responsible person of the winning boat of the championship acquires the title "Klassenkampioen", and the Red Pennant of the RNSA.

Other prizes will be given as follows: Medals for Helmsman and Crew of the first three boats in the final results.

Contender Class:

Daily prizes for the best finishing Contender helmsman of that day will be provided at the end of each day (after protests have been heard).

The Dutch Contender helmsman with the best overall results will be provided the perpetual prize for the best finishing Dutch helm.

Efsix Class:

An extra Red Pennant of the RNSA for the crew of the winning boat will be provided.

FD Class:

Cle Jeldes Perpetual Trophy for the best placed boat overall.

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 per incident or the equivalent.

19 REGATTA OFFICE

The Regatta Office is located inside the sailing school . The sailing school is located at the West side of the harbour.

20 TRAILER PARKING, DOCKING AND CARS

All participants shall park their boats and road-trailers on the premises of the harbour. Cars shall be parked in the designated parking areas near the Regatta Office. No cars are allowed at the dinghy park. Please follow the beach master's and the harbour master's instructions at all times.

21 HOUSING AND CAMPERS/CARAVANS

Regulations in the Netherlands prohibit sleeping in campers and caravans parked along public roads or in public car parks. For camping sites see below.
