NOTICE OF RACE

VENUE

The Royal Yacht Club Hollandia takes pleasure in inviting you to participate in the Medemblik Trophy 2017 for the Kielzugvogel and Flying Junior classes.

The event will be held from 6 – 8 July inclusive and will be sailed on the IJsselmeer off Medemblik, the Netherlands.

The Organizing Authority is the Royal Yacht Club Hollandia.

Since this event will consist of the Open Dutch Championship for the Flying Junior class and a class event for the Kielzugvogel class this Notice of Race consists of two parts.

Part 1 (Kielzugvogel class only)

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The ranking factor for the German ranking is 1.45.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions may contain minor changes to the rules.
- 1.7 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING [DP]

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Kielzugvogel class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by registration with the Organizing Authority.
- 3.3 Entries shall be made on the website: www.kzrvhollandia.nl.
- 3.4 Entry closes at 2 July 2018. Late entries will be accepted upon registration on Friday 6 July before 10:00 only.

4 FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee (including crane) is € 90 per boat
- 4.2 The entry fee is payable at registration.

7 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

Boats and crews may be inspected during the regatta at the discretion of the Race Committee.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 08:30 on Friday 6 July at the race office located in the Regatta Center Medemblik.

10 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be triangle-windward-leeward courses with an upwind finish.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

No international Jury will be appointed.

12 SCORING

12.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

12.2 (a) When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

- (b) When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13 SPARE

14 BERTHING [DP]

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the harbour.

15 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS [DP]

Keel boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

16 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS [DP]

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keel boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

17 RADIO COMMUNICATION [DP]

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

18 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

- One series prize for helmsman and crew per six (6) boats entered before 29 June;
- Medemblik Trophy, a perpetual trophy for the helmsman in the first boat of the series;
- Hollandia Uhr, perpetual trophy;
- Sonderpreis, perpetual trophy for the crew who had to make the longest trip to come to Medemblik (from the place where the helmsman lives).

19 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

20 SPARE

21 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 1.500.000 per incident or the equivalent.

22 FURTHER INFORMATION

- 22.1** Please be aware that this championship will be combined with the Open Dutch Championship for the Flying Junior Class. The expected number of participating boats in this championship is less than 20.

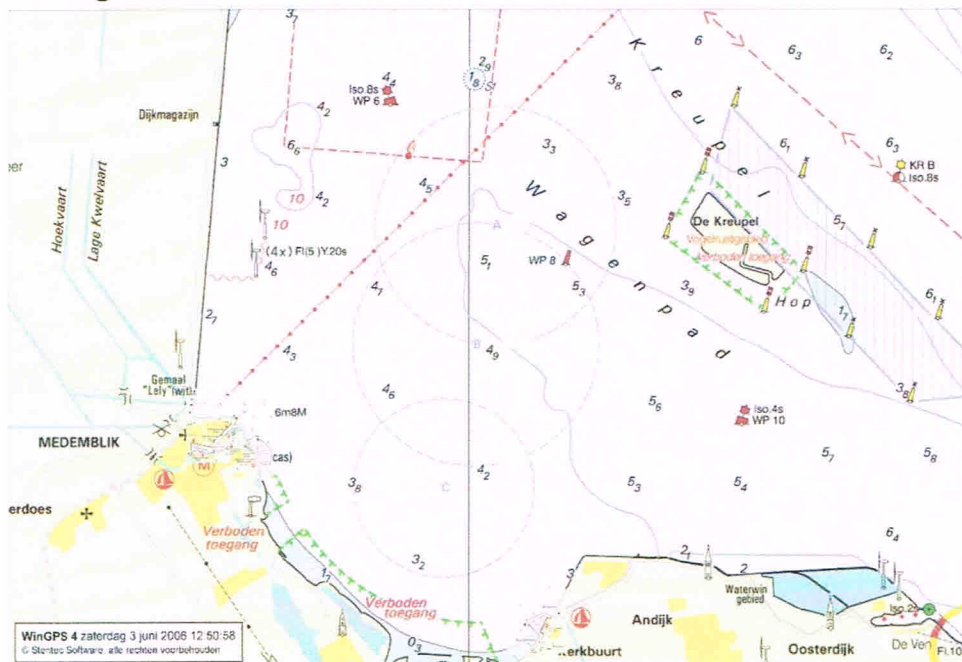

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the RNYU will apply (see http://www.sailing.org/documents/racingrules/national_prescriptions.php)
- 1.3 The 'Rules for Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding' will apply.
- 1.4 The sailing instructions may contain minor changes to the RRS.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.6 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.

2 ADVERTISING [DP]

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Flying Junior class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter before 2 July 2018 with the Organizing Authority at the website www.kzrvhollandia.nl
- 3.3 Late entries will be accepted upon registration on Friday 6 July 2018 only.

4 FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee is € 65 per boat.
- 4.2 The entry fee is payable at registration.

- 6.3** Competitors shall be available with their boat for measurement and inspection on Saturday 7 July no later than 9:00. **[DP]**
- 6.4** On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 15:00 hrs.

7 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate. In addition equipment may be inspected or measured.

10 THE COURSES

The course to be sailed will be a Triangle – Windward – Leeward Course with an upwind finish.

11 SPARE

12 SCORING

12.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

12.2 (a) When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When five (5) or six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13 SUPPORT BOATS [DP]

13.1 Support boats shall register with the Organizing Authority before Saturday 7 July 2018, 10:30.

13.2 Support boats shall be marked with a conspicuously displayed flag, with a minimum height of 200 mm of the country they represent.

14 BERTHING [DP]

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park and harbour.

15 SPARE

17 RADIO COMMUNICATION [DP]

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

18 PRIZES

18.1 Helmsman and crew of the winning boat of the championship acquire the title "Dutch Champion Flying Junior 2018" and receive the accompanying medals of the RNYU.

18.2 Helmsman and crew of the winning boat acquires the Blue Pennant of the RNYU.

18.3 Helmsman and crew of the boats that are placed second and third acquire also medals of the RNYU.

18.4 The sailing instructions may describe more prizes.

19 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

20 RIGHTS TO USE NAMES AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the

venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

21 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 per event or the equivalent.

22 FURTHER INFORMATION

22.1 Please be aware that this championship will be combined with the Medemblik Trophy, a class event organized by RYC Hollandia and the Kielzugvogel class. The expected number of participating boats in the Medemblik Trophy is less than eighteen (18).

23 TRAILER PARKING, DOCKING AND CARS [DP]

All competitors and support persons shall park their boats and road-trailers on the premises of the harbour Regatta Center Medemblik. Cars shall be parked in the designated parking area near the race office. No cars are allowed to park at the dinghy park. Please follow the beach master's and the harbour master's instructions at all times.

23 HOUSING AND CAMPERS/CARAVANS

Regulations in the Netherlands prohibit sleeping in campers, tents and caravans parked along public roads or in public car parks. On the designated area on the premises of the harbour Regatta Center Medemblik, sleeping in tents, caravans or campers is allowed, provided a fee of € 19 per camper/caravan per night. For small tents (four persons max) the fee will be € 10. The fee for other tents will be € 15. The fee is payable at the regatta office (located next to the race office).

Tourist tax, free use of power and access card for free use of the regatta center's sanitary facilities is included in the above mentioned fee.
