NOTICE OF RACE

VENUE

The Royal Yacht Club Hollandia takes pleasure in inviting you to participate in the Spring Regatta 2019 for the Contender and Flying Dutchman (FD).

The Spring Regatta will be held on Saturday 29 June and Sunday 30 June 2019. The event will be sailed on the IJsselmeer off Medemblik, the Netherlands.

The Organizing Authority is the Royal Yacht Club Hollandia.

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2** The prescriptions of the Royal Netherlands Yachting Union (RNYU) will apply. See http://www.sailing.org/documents/racingrules/national_prescriptions.php .
- 1.3** The sailing instructions may contain minor changes to the RRS and they will appear in full in the sailing instructions.
- 1.4** If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.5** Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall be a member of a Yacht Club or other body affiliated to the RNYU and shall have the appropriate license.

2 ADVERTISING [DP]

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the Contender and Flying Dutchman classes.
- 3.2** Eligible boats may enter before 24 June 2019 with the Organizing Authority at the website www.kzrvhollandia.nl .
- 3.3** Late entries will be accepted upon registration on Saturday 29 June before 09.30.

4 FEES

- 4.1** The entry fee is:

Contender class	€ 46 per boat
Flying Dutchman Class	€ 56 per boat
- 4.2** The entry fee is payable upon registration.

* Warning signal for the Contender class will be made at least three (3) minutes after a valid start of the FD class.

5.2 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 14:30 hrs.

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

Boats and crews may be inspected during the regatta at the discretion of the race committee.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 08:30 on Saturday 29 June at the race office located in the Regatta Center Medemblik.

The sailing instructions will also be published on the website www.kzrvhollandia.nl when available.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be (triangle-)windward-leeward courses with upwind finish as specified in te sailing instructions.

10 SCORING

10.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 10.2 (a) When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When five (5) or six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 SUPPORT BOATS [DP]

11.1 Support boats shall register with the Organizing Authority before 11:30 on Saturday 29 June.

11.2 Support boats shall be marked with a conspicuously displayed flag of the country they represent, with a minimum height of 200 mm.

12 BERTHING [DP]

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park and harbour.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION [DP]

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

14 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

- For each class a series prize for every six boats entered before 21 June. The respective class associations may also award special prizes.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16 RIGHTS TO USE NAMES AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

17 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 1.500.000 per incident or the equivalent.

18 TRAILER PARKING, DOCKING AND CARS [DP]

All competitors and support persons shall park their boats and road-trailers on the premises of the harbour Regatta Center Medemblik. Cars shall be parked in the designated parking areas near the race office. No cars are allowed to park at the dinghy park. Please follow the beach master's and the harbour master's instructions at all times.

19 HOUSING AND CAMPERS/CARAVANS

Regulations in the Netherlands prohibit sleeping in campers, tents and caravans parked along public roads or in public car parks. ***Please note that the dingy park is a public road!!*** On the designated area on the premises of the harbour Regatta Center Medemblik, sleeping in tents, caravans or campers is allowed, provided a fee of € 19.00 per camper/caravan per night. For small tents (four persons max) the fee will be € 10; the fee for other tents will be € 15. The fee is payable at the regatta office (next to the race office).

Tourist tax, free use of power and access card for free use of the regatta center's sanitary facilities are included in the abovementioned fees.

20 ACCOMMODATION
